Los Angeles City Council Redistricting Commission Begins Public Input Hearings *Three-Month Process will Collect Testimony from Communities Throughout the City*

What: The Los Angeles City Council Redistricting Commission (LACCRC) will begin taking testimony from communities across the city. LACCRC will host a total of 19 public hearings between July 1st and September 25th, 2021 to provide ample opportunity for Angelenos to voice their interests and provide input on the redrawing of new Council District maps. The first meeting will take place virtually on July 1st to hear from residents of Council District 12.

Every 10 years, as mandated by the U.S. Constitution, the entire country goes through a process called “redistricting” to redraw district maps. Redistricting is intended to make the corrections and adjustments needed to make districts fair, equal, and representative to the people living in them. Every person in the City of LA lives in a city council district - each made up and defined by different neighborhoods and street boundaries.
