Los Angeles City Council Redistricting Commission's Comments on Release of 2020 Census Redistricting Data

The release of the 2020 Census Redistricting Data is an important and welcomed announcement for redistricting efforts throughout the country. We are pleased this census data has finally been released to the public and look forward to receiving, analyzing, and sharing the information.

On Thursday, August 19 at 6 p.m. [via Zoom](#) the Los Angeles City Council Redistricting Commission 2021 will present with Commissioners and members of the public what this data means to the City of Los Angeles.

This census data – which shows the City of Los Angeles' population grew by 2.8% from 3.79 million in 2010 to 3.89 million in 2020 – together with other sources such as the American Community Survey (ACS) and the community of interest [public testimony](#) we've received and will receive in the future will help inform the Commission in drawing council district maps in an inclusive and transparent way for the City of Los Angeles. We also want to note given the way the 2020 Census was conducted, that the Commission wants to better understand the quality of the data that was released today.

The mission of the Los Angeles City Council Redistricting Commission is to make sure that all community members have fair and equal representation on the Los Angeles City Council.
