Re: UNNC Resolution on City Council Redistricting

Dear Commissioners,

The United Neighborhoods of the Historic Arlington Heights, West Adams and Jefferson Park Communities Neighborhood Council (UNNC), representing 80,000 stakeholders, met in a Brown Act-compliant public Governing Board meeting on Thursday, September 2, 2021 and approved the following Motion/Resolution:

“UNNC requests that the Redistricting Commission keep UNNC in one council district, and that the district be CD10.”

UNNC discussed our goal (and desire) to not divide community of interests, of which NCs are a type. UNNC values our diversity (faith, race, gender identification, age) and consistently supports a balance between the past, present and future: we value our historic neighborhoods, our existing communities, and look to a prosperous future that includes change, growth and new residents.

We understand and support the interest in the Koreatown community to be one district, not divided into four sections as is currently the case. However, we would hope this does not affect UNNC if this change is carried through; if at all feasible, we would like to keep our footprint – generally speaking, Pico to Exposition, with a variable eastern border of Normandie north of the freeway and Western/Arlington south of the freeway, west to Crenshaw – within one council district, which historically has been Council District 10.
