The Commission will meet on Wednesday, October 13 to consider first the following agenda item:

Commission Draft Map: Summary of Commission Draft Map; Public Hearing to gather testimony on Commission Draft Map; Discussion and possible action regarding Commission Draft Map, including but not limited to providing direction to staff to prepare and present modifications to the Commission Draft Map for future Commission consideration.

After the introduction of the agenda item, I will open up public testimony for approximately 90 minutes.

At the conclusion of public testimony, the Commission will consider modifications to draft Map K2.5 in the South Region 1, and the West Region 3. If time allows, we will also begin discussing modifications to the San Fernando Valley Region 4 map.

Following the modifications, the Commission will also consider two contracts for language justice services.

The Saturday, October 16 meeting will follow a similar format. Following public testimony, we will complete discussion of potential modifications to the Region 4 map. On Monday, October 18, we will discuss modifications to the eastern Region 2 map.

A sample list of potential modifications that have been identified through public testimony or by staff that are being reviewed by Redistricting Partner follows:

Region 1

- Maintaining Ladera Heights in CD11
- Economic assets of CD 8 and CD 9

Region 2

- Unifying Chinatown in CD1
- Griffith Park (Neighborhood Council boundary) connected with Los Feliz in CD13
- Highland Park within CD14

- Lincoln Heights within CD14

#### Region 3

- Melrose Unification in CD5
- Franklin Canyon into CD5
- Carthay Square / Mid City west unification in CD 5

#### Region 4

- Within CD12, border between CD12 and 7 as the San Diego Freeway and not Aqueduct St
- Sepulveda Basin connected to Encino in CD3
- Sun Valley area splits
- Canoga Park area splits
- Shadow Hills connection to CD7
- Armenian community unification

Redistricting Partners is also planning to present information on Renter Burden, as well as the recently proposed People's Bloc map, once additional information is provided by the respective map-makers.
